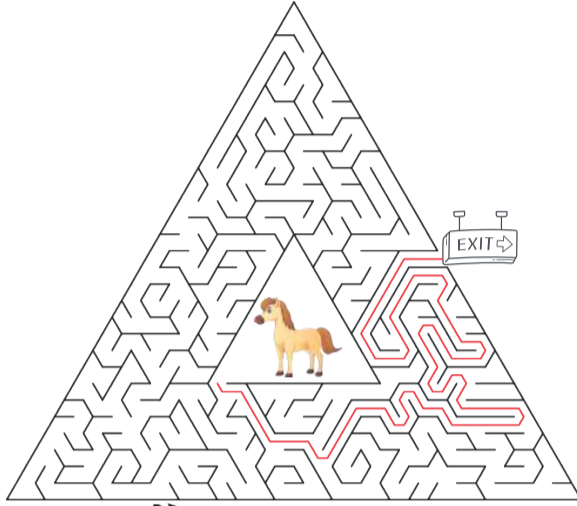

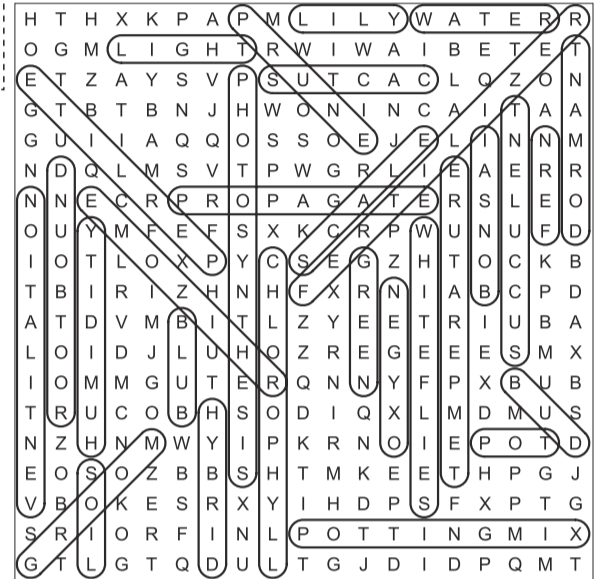

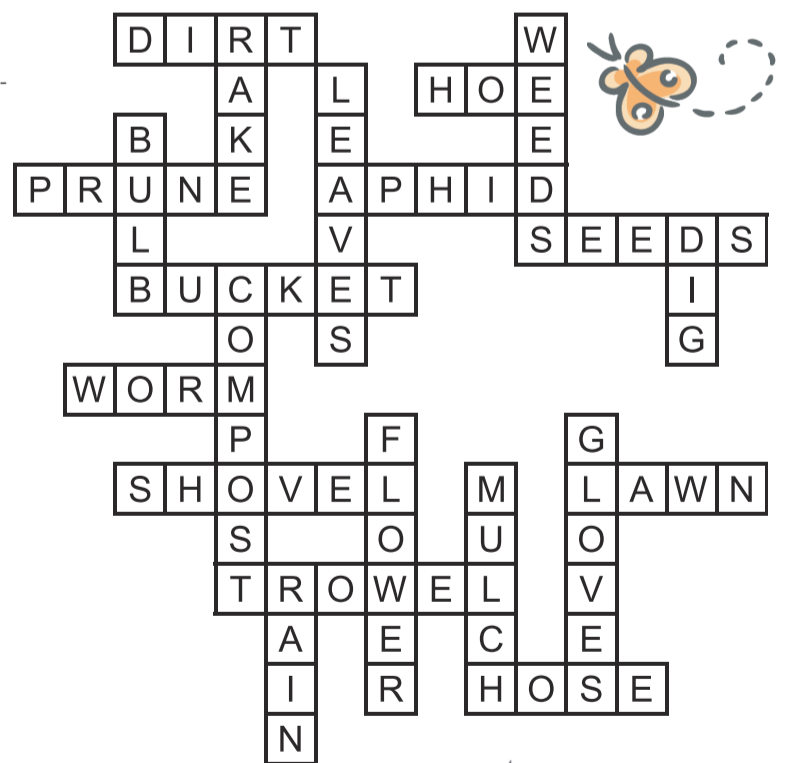


ACROSS
