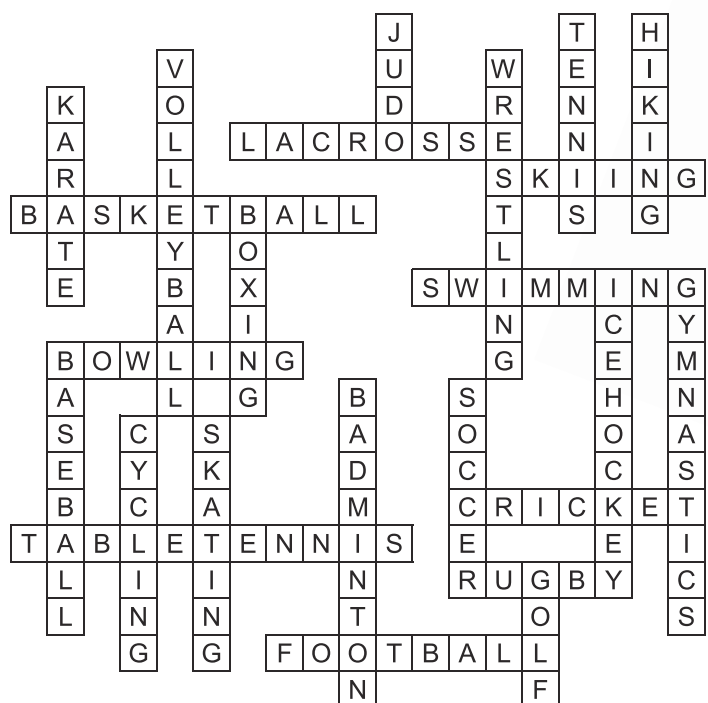




## How well do you know your sport?

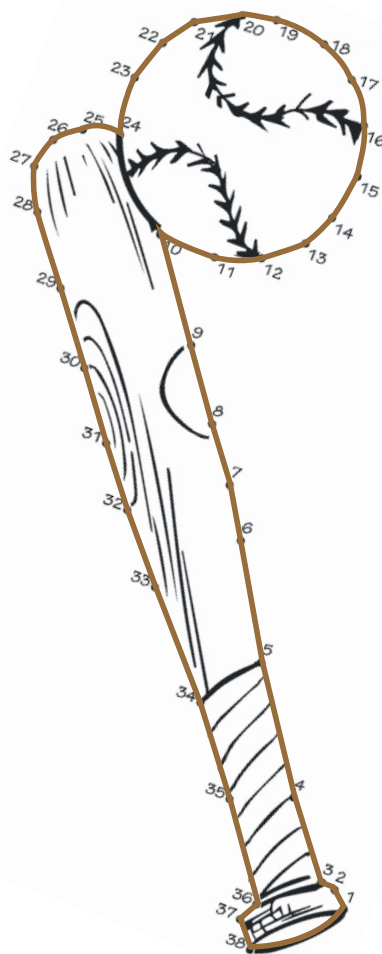

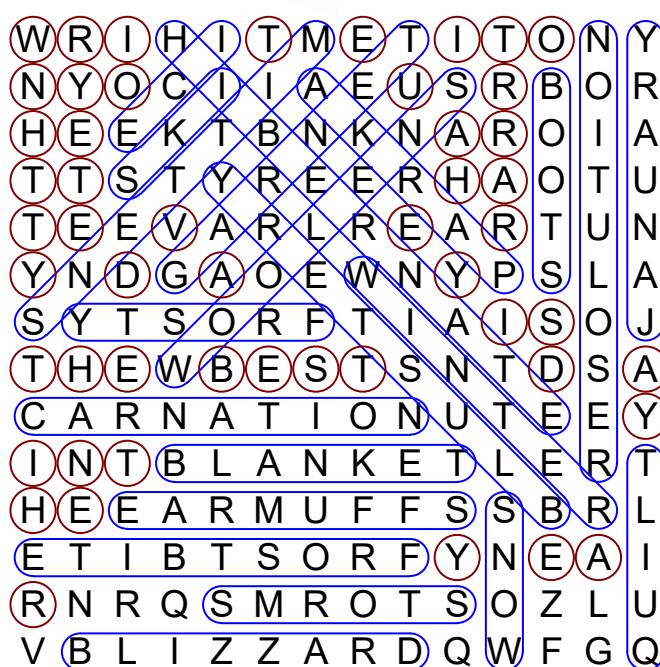

Record-Breaking Matches: The longest tennis match lasted 11 hours and 5 minutes.



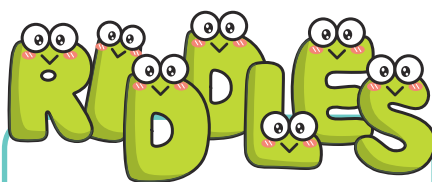
