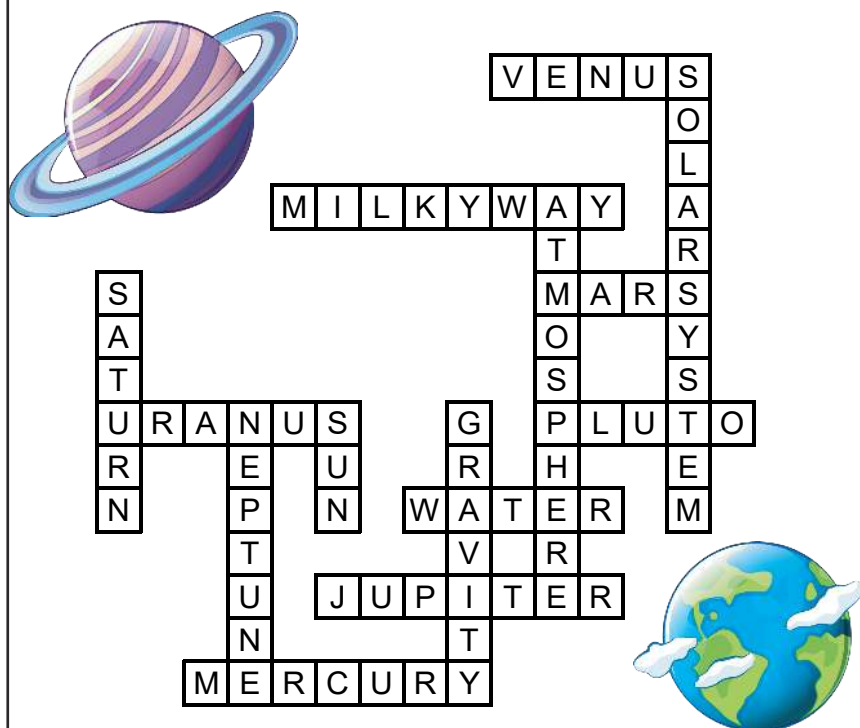

ACROSS

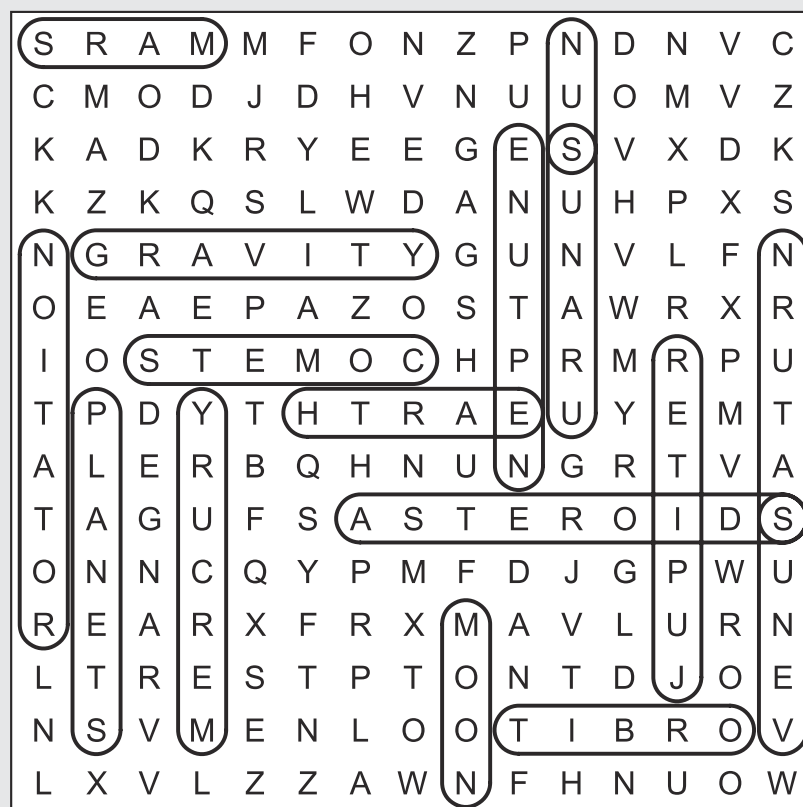
- Planet named after the Roman goddess of love and beauty.

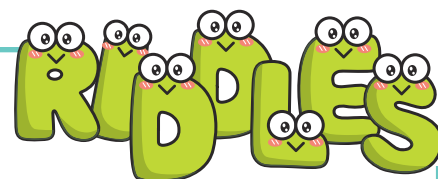

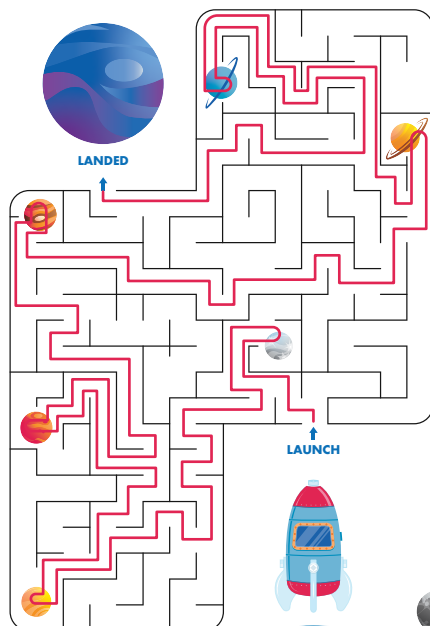
