We celebrate our first-ever Grade 12 cohort with immense pride and gratitude. As a school community, we recognise that this group did far more than write the National Senior Certificate (NSC) examinations - the bedrock of an incredible university future. They made history. As our pioneering matric class, these 58 learners established a blueprint for excellence and laid a solid foundation for the almost 900 learners who follow. Their journey reflects the power of the teacher-parent-learner triangle: accountability held, support given, and learners showing up to deliver quality results. Their commitment, discipline and perseverance are evident in outcomes that include 32 subject distinctions, with two learners achieving three distinctions each. We recorded a 100% pass rate in Mathematical Literacy, siSwati, Tourism and Life Orientation, alongside strong performances in English Home Language (98%), Physical Sciences (88%) and Mathematics (80%). Our 2025 top achiever, Ayesha Nauman, exemplifies the impact

of steadfast parental support. Our 2025 Head Leaders, Skhumbuzo Ngobeni and Sinokulunga Dlamini, quietly embodied grit - navigating matric speedhumps that often felt insurmountable yet consistently showing up. As these learners prepare to soar locally and abroad, as their hearts desire, we count ourselves privileged to have contributed to their workmanship.
