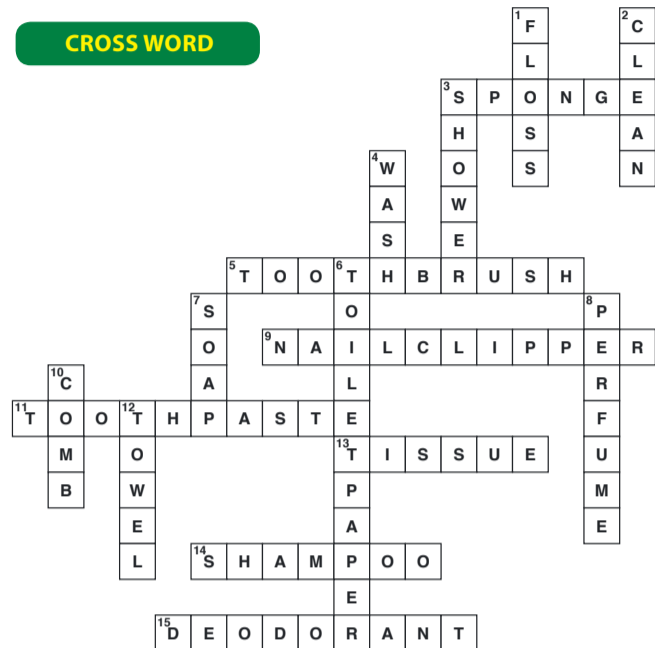

  - [15] Something that keeps you smelling fresh.

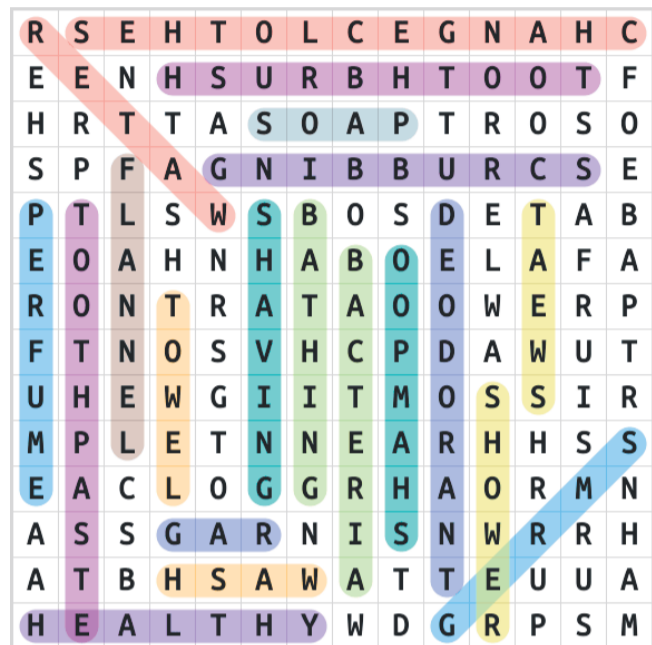

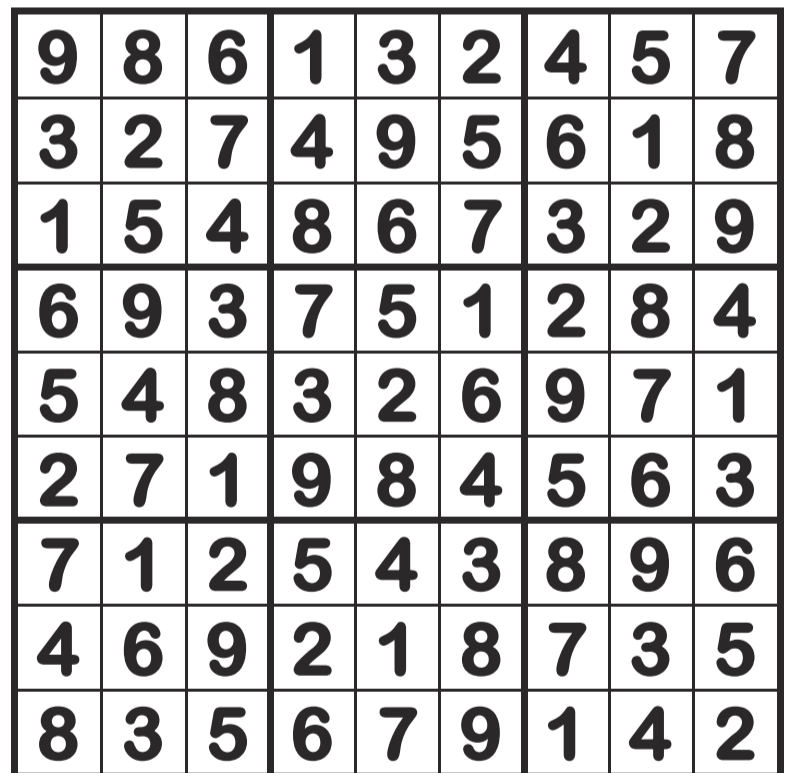

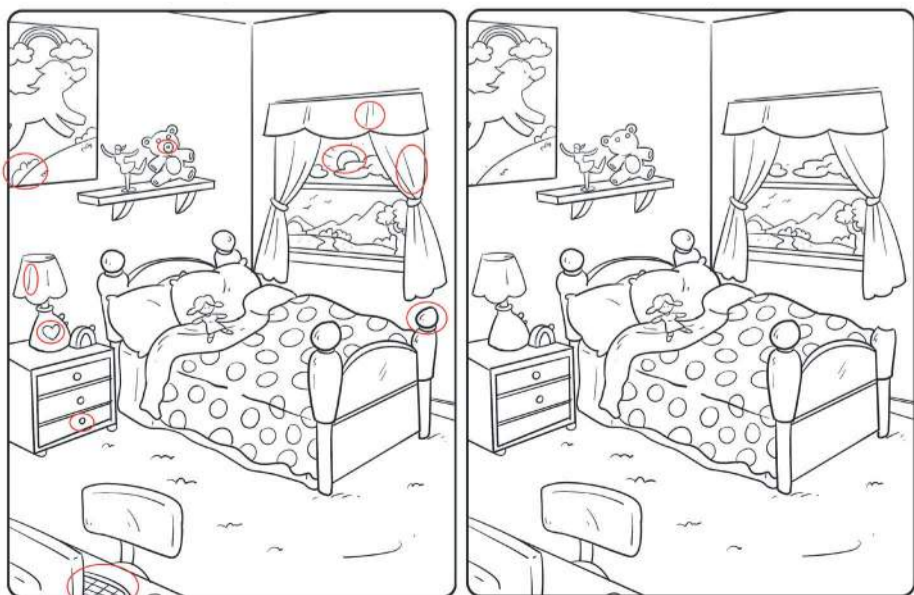
Fill the grid with numbers 1-5.
