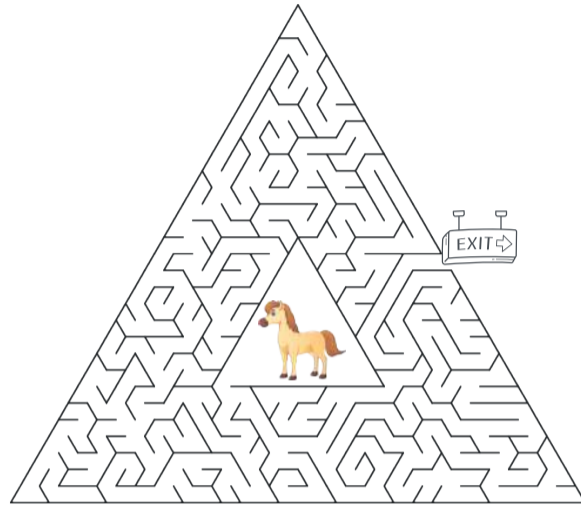

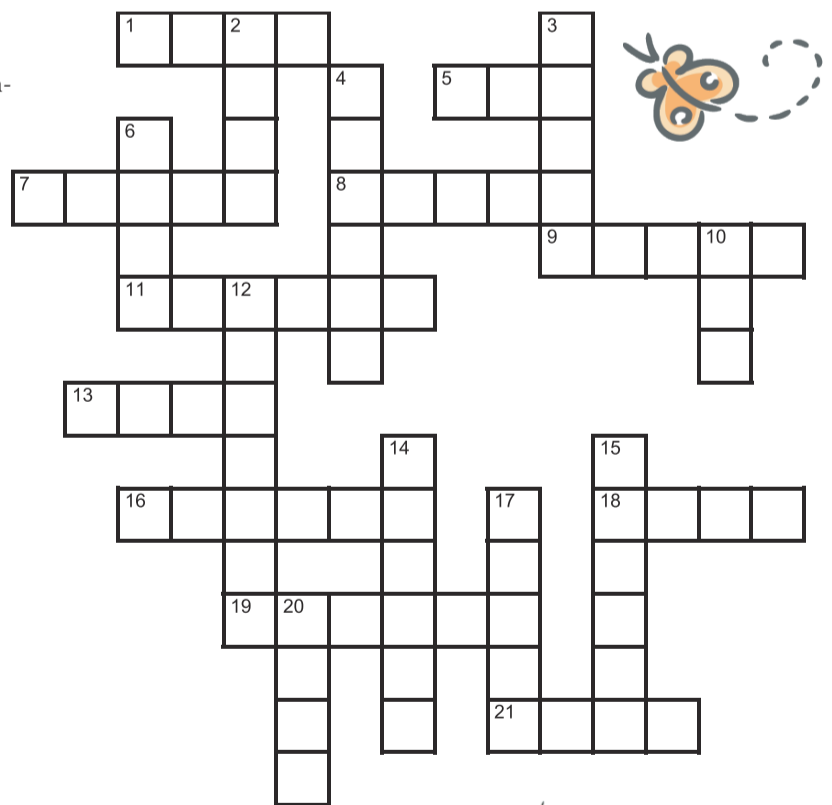

- Top layer of soil.
 - Tool with a flat blade used for turning soil.
 - To trim or remove parts of a plant for better growth.
 - Small insect that feeds on plants.
 - We put these in the ground and plants grow from them.
 - Container used for carrying water or soil.
 - Long, slender invertebrate that lives in soil.
 - Tool used to dig holes.
 - Area of grass.
 - Small handheld tool used for digging.
 - Flexible tube used for watering plants.

- Tool with teeth used for collecting leaves.
 - Unwanted plants that compete with desired plants.
 - Green, flat structures of a plant.
 - Underground storage organ of some plants, such as a tulip.
 - Break up and turn over soil with a tool.
