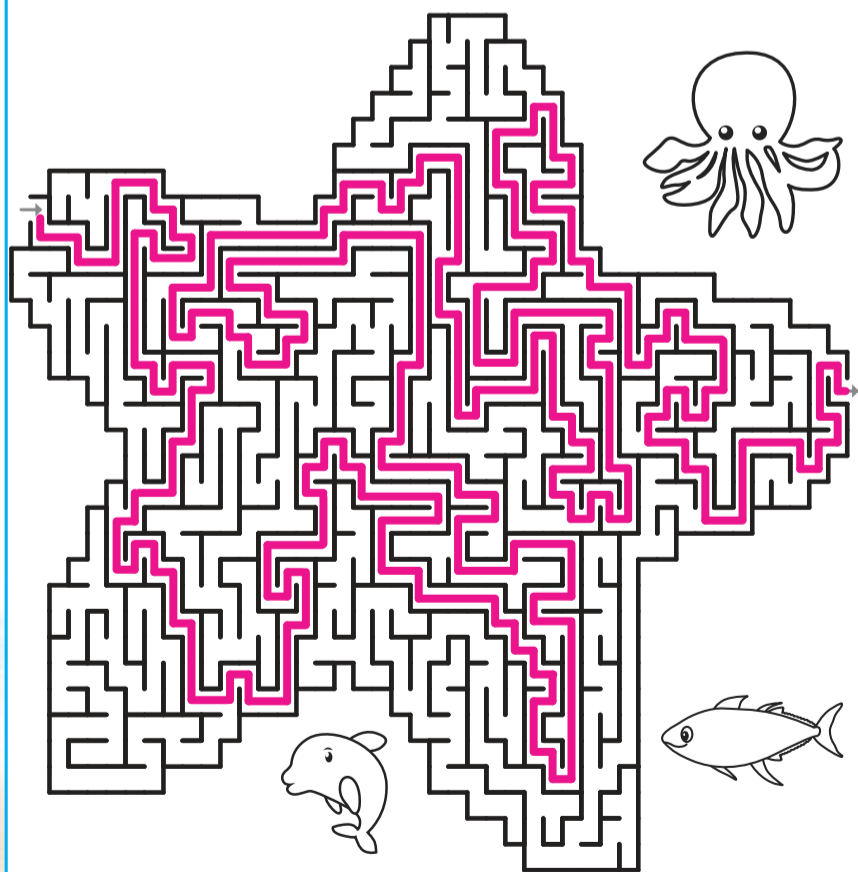
- Sea creature with five arms that lives on the sea floor

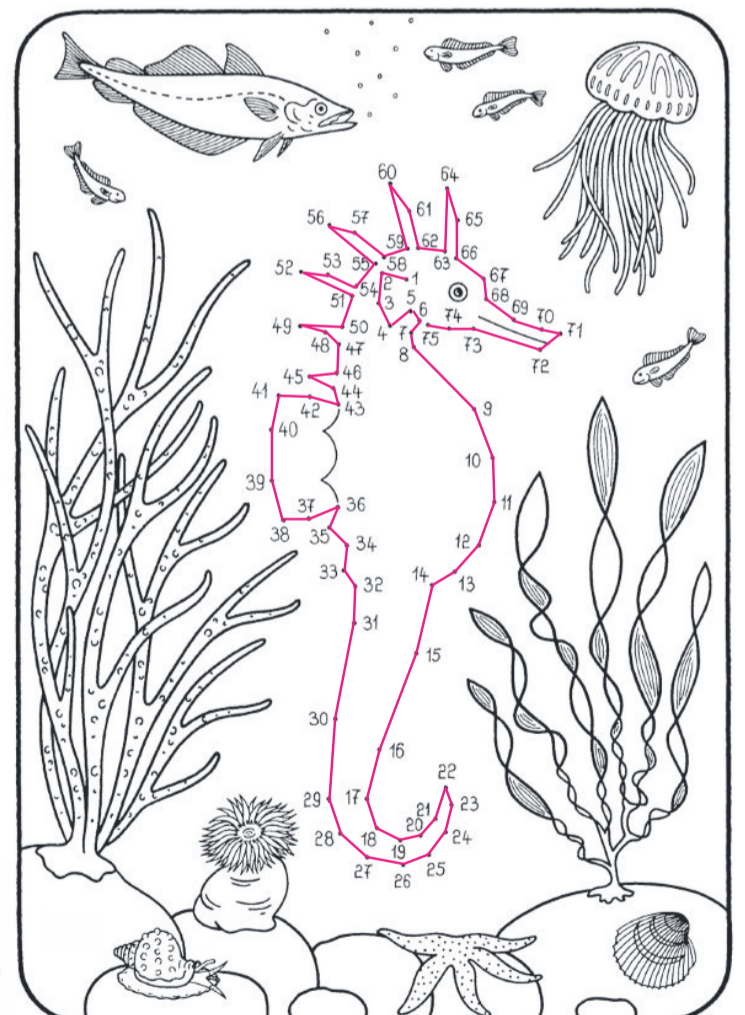


FUN FACTS ABOUT SEA ANIMALS
