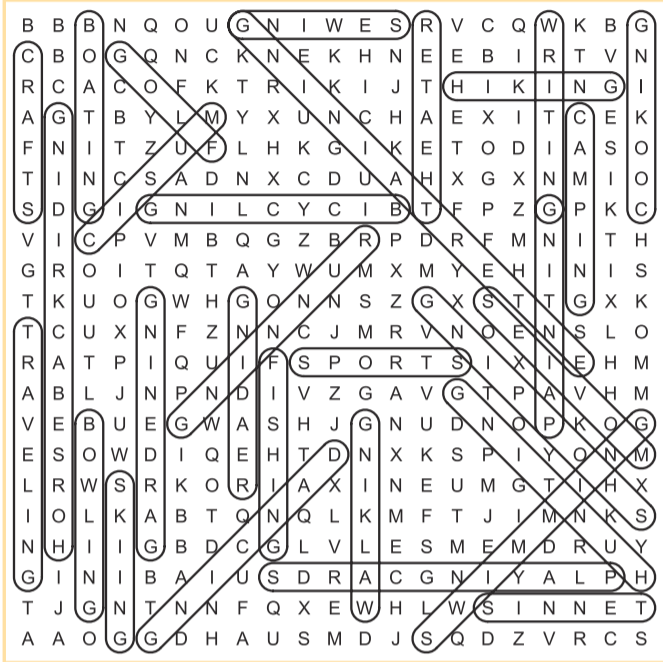

- A person who claims to predict the future and answer questions about your life.

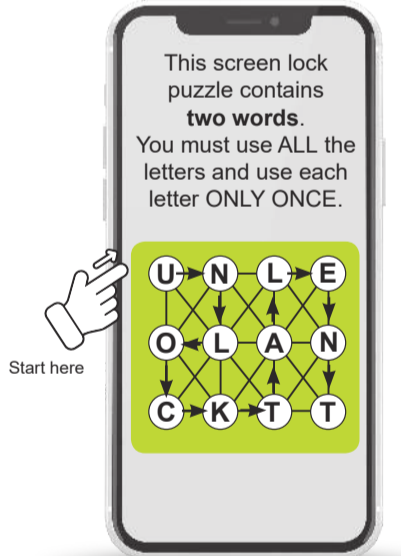
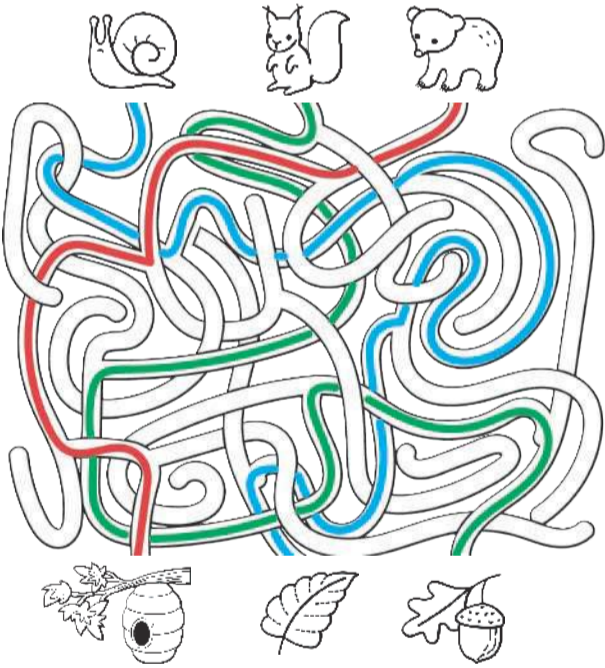

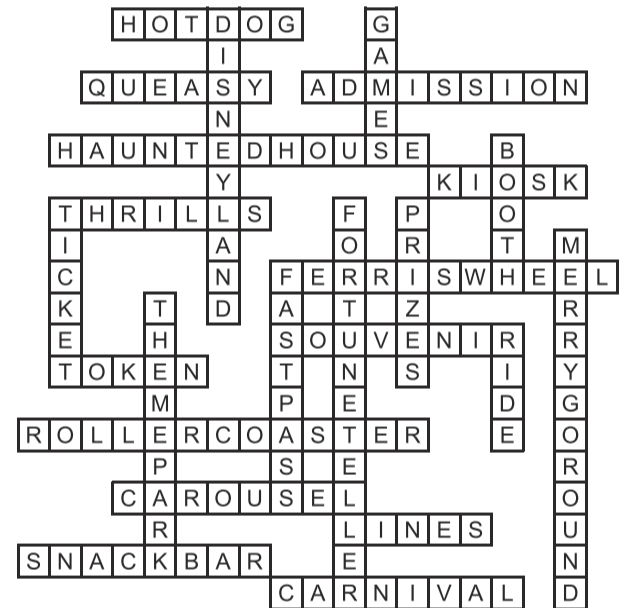
