<p>Zuma states: "If this stance is considered to be a violation of their law, then let their law take its course."</p> <p>Feb 2021</p>										<p>THE DEREK HANEKOM INCIDENT</p>
<p>Zuma says he does not fear being arrested and convicted for defying the apex court.</p> <p>Feb 2021</p>										<p>ACCUSATION Hanekom takes Zuma to court for defamation of character following Zuma's Tweets that Hanekom is a "known enemy agent."</p> <p>Aug 2019</p>
<p>Zuma's lawyer states that they "respectfully disagree" that the former president is obligated to appear from the 18 to the 22 January this year.</p> <p>Jan 2021</p>										<p>RESULT The court finds Zuma's statement to be false and defaming.</p> <p>Sep 2019</p>
<p>Two cases are lodged against Zuma due to him walking out of the commission without permission.</p> <p>Nov 2020</p>										<p>The court orders Zuma to issue a full and unconditional apology and a retraction of his allegations.</p>
<p>He returns to SA after medical treatments in Cuba and tells his supporters: "I have never feared prison. Even under the apartheid regime I attended and they convicted me and I spent 10 years in jail and came out handsome."</p> <p>Feb 2020</p>										<p>AFTERMATH Hanekom accepts Zuma's apology but still wants Zuma to fork out R500,000 for damage caused to his reputation.</p> <p>Aug 2019</p>
<p>KEEP POST-PONING TO REACH THE END</p> 										<p>Jacob Zuma is too sick to appear at the Commission of Inquiry into State Capture. He leaves for Cuba for medical treatment some time later.</p> <p>Nov 2019</p>
