

# Desert to bloom in Cape 

RECORD: DE KOCK SEEKING FOURTH WIN IN G1 CAPE FILLIES GUINEAS

## $\leadsto$ Pace a concern in Green Point Stakes

Desert Miracle is alesert Miracle is al-
ready being compared ready being compared
to "The Galloping Goldmine", Empress Club, as she has been a runaway winner of all her races this season.

However, she will face her sternest test so far when she lines up in the Grade 1 World Sports Betting Cape Fillies Guineas over 1600m at Kenilworth tomorrow.

It is apparent no three-yearold on the Highveld can live with Desert Miracle and now she needs to prove she can beat the best in the Western Cape. This time she has to do the travelling and will race for the first time on a left-handed turn.
Trainer Mike de Kock knows what it takes to win this race, having first taken top honours in 2003 with Emerald Beauty and then again with Rumya in 2012 and Majmu in 2014.

Desert Miracle has run six times, and after two unlucky seconds over 116om at Turffontein, she went on to win her next four with consummate ease.
This beautifully bred daughter of Dynasty does look special, and it come as no surprise she has been priced up at 4-10.

Gavin Lerena knows her well and he is back in the irons on this occasion. They will jump from No 6 draw.

The home challenge is headed up by Candice Bass-Robinsontrained Amanzimtoti, winner of the Grade 2 Western Cape Fillies Championship. She has won three of her five starts and finished runner-up in the other two

but she will have to jump from barrier No 12 which means jockey Aldo Domeyer will already start at a disadvantage.

However, racing is now back on the Summer Course and with it's longer run-in, should make life easier for jockeys who need to come from off the pace.

Another highlight on the card is the Grade 2 Green Point Stakes over 1600 m , a traditional warmup for the Grade 1 L'Ormarins Queen's Plate over the same course and distance.

Jet Dark, winner of the Queen's Plate last season, is on track to defend his crown and returns
after a four-month absence since winning the Grade 1 Champions Cup over 1800 m at Greyville.

Only five runners are carded to go to post, but they all have winning chances.

The others are consistent top level performer Rainbow Bridge who impressed in a recent racecourse gallop, Vaughan Marshalltrained Linebacker and Seeking The Stars, and highly regarded Captain Fontane, who takes a jump in class and tries this distance for the first time. But he is lightly raced and is likely to be a lot better than his merit rating suggests.

This race has "Cape Crawl" written all over it as only Seeking The Stars is an obvious front runner.

Anton Marcus is aboard so the other jockeys will have to keep him firmly in their sights or else he will ride them to sleep.
One should put all five runners in one's Pick 6 but Rainbow Bridge has to be the sentimental choice to pick up another Graded race victory.
The Grade 2 Southern Cross Stakes over 1000m for fillies and mares looks highly competitive as does the Grade 3 Cape Summer Stayers Handicap over 2500 m .

Trainer Alan Greeff and jockey Greg Cheyne have been in excellent form of last and they are ex pected to add to their winning tally at Fairview today where racing takes place on the Polytrack.

There best could come up as early in Race 2, a Maiden Plate for fillies and mares over 1200m, where they team up with a newcomer to the stable, Opulence.
This three-year-old Duke Of Marmalade filly comes across from Candice Bass-Robinson for whom she has raced four times. After two disappointing runs blinkers were fitted and Opulent started to show improvement. In her last start, over 1600 m at $\mathrm{Ke}-$ nilworth, she went down a short head to Costa Smeralda. Two winners from six runner have come out of that form line so it is quite clear a repeat of that performance will make her very hard to beat.
She does drop to 1200 m and will try the Polytrack for the first time, but Greeff is quite astute when making those changes and does so with great success. In any case, she does have the strongest form line in the field.

Cheyne and Greeff look very likely to notch up a quick double with Celtillus in Race 3.
This Vercingetorix gelding has done well since joining the Greeff yard and loves this Polytrack surface.

Surprisingly, the five-year-old has been carded to race in blinkers this time but if that does not trouble him, coupled with the fact he will jump from the stall No 1 , should see him have the run of the race.

Another trainer having a very good year is Gavin Smith and he could win Race 7 with his recent recruit Senescence.
This five-year-old mare was not disgraced when third on her local debut and she is likely to be smarter this time.

# Grimaldi looks set to make winning return 

WEIGHT: PETER'S CHARGE TO BENEFIT FROM A 4KG APPRENTICE CLAIM

Grimaldi has had a threemonth break and if anywhere close to his best will ake some beating in Race at Turffontein tomor-

The Paul Peter-trained runner lines up in a merit rated 72 Handicap over 2000 m on the Standside track and his trainer could not have unearthed a better race for his charge to make his comeback.

Grimaldi could not come from better stock. His sire, Dynasty, was the best racehorse of his era in the country with victories in a number of the country's most prominent races. Sadly, an injury forced him into early retirement.

The same could be said of his dam Europa Point was sired in Ireland and was trained by Mike de Kock in South Africa. As she was six months younger than her local rivals De Kock showed a lot of patience with her and allowed her time to develop by racing her through the divisions.

When she finally matured Europa Point started to race against and beat

the best. She raced 13 times for nine wins and four places, ending her career with two Grade 1 wins - over 1600m and 2000m respectively. Grimaldi had his issues as a youngster and while not in the same league of his illustrious parents he is more than capable. Like his mother, he took a while to mature but in his 11 starts, he has a record of two wins
and seven places.

Saturday's race is not at all strong, but he has been allocated a great leveller of 62 kg . Fortunately, Peter has engaged a competent 4 kg claiming apprentice in Kaidan Brewer and that will make him highly competitive.

The main threat is likely to come from Call Me Master. While he is cur-
rently in good form the Robbie Sagetrained runner is already five years old and has only notched up one win. However, he has been lightly raced and is another who has only raced 11 times.

He does have a top a jockey in Muzi Yeni up and he will know how to deal with any nerves the young apprentice might have.

## Superb first entries for Cape Met

The first entries for this season's Cape Town Met closed on Wednesday and just 19 horses were nominated for this Grade 1 race over 2000m at Kenilworth on Saturday 29 January.

But it is as good a 19-horse field that can be assembled!

They are all there - Do It Again, Rainbow Bridge, Jet Dark, Kommetdieding, Linebacker Malmoos and War Of Athena.

Add Russian Rock, Rascallion and Marina into the group and
we potently have one of the best fields ever amassed for this R2 million race.

This race is run at weight for age terms and once again, the winner can lay claim to being the best middle-distance runner in the land.

The first supplementary entries close on Monday 20 December with final supplementary entries closing on 10 January after which the weights will be announced.

Declarations close at 11am on Wednesday 19 January. The draws will be made electronically by the NRB on the same day.

## Kingdom come for Nicholls

London - Brave Kingdom can make it two from two for Paul Nicholls as he takes a marked step up in class in the Ballymore Winter Novices' Hurdle at Sandown today.

The five-year-old only joined the champion trainer this season having started out his career with Harry Whittington, winning a bumper in impressive style at Fontwell back in February on his only run for the latter.

Brave Kingdom transferred to Nicholls' care over the summer after having wind surgery in July, and he looked every bit as promising a prospect in winning a Chepstow maiden hurdle by 9.50 lengths at the start of November.

He made all that day and was certainly far from all out in vic tory, suggesting there is plenty still to come.

Brave Kingdom's future appears to lie over fences, but this Grade 2 heat looks a perfect stepping stone.

Desque De L'Isle can enhance his already impressive statistics of three wins in his last five out ings by landing the Betfair Exchange Handicap Chase. Venetia Williams' runner struck twice at Lingfield last year before losing his way a bit in two subsequent starts.

Another to have had a summer wind surgery, the eight-year-old kicked off the season with victory at Ffos Las at the beginning of November, triumphing by 1.50 lengths but looking fair value for the distance.

The handicapper was clearly of a similar view as Desque De L'Isle is now on a 4 kg higher mark, which puts him on a career high of 120 - although it still does not look insurmount able for this lightly raced individual.

Stoner's Choice can land the Pertemps Network Handicap Hurdle after finishing third in another qualifier at Kempton on his reappearance.
He could not quite cope with two race-fit rivals in Sunbury losing out on second place in the shadow of the post but should be much sharper for this contest. Press Association

## Peter looks to have some good raiders at Scottsville

After a break in order to scarify the Scottsville track, racing will return to the Maritzburg track on Sunday.

This, of course, gives a full test to the jockeys as the Scottsville straight always holds a number of surprises and after a break the riders will have to find the best going when racing up the straight.

Highveld trainer Paul Peter
has brought a raiding party of four to the track and he could come away with some winners on the card. He saddles Miss Cool in Race 1 a Maiden Juvenile Plate over 8oom. Although she will be taking on the colts, she has the advantage of already having had a race in which she finished a 3.25 -length fifth behind stablemate Fennec Fox.
With Warren Kennedy up, she should get the yard of to a winning start.

He could be back in the win-
ner's enclosure in Race 4, a Maiden Plate over 1500m, with Displace Time, also with Kennedy up. While a track debut at Scottsville is seldom easy, Displace Time does not look to be meeting a strong field and is drawn in barrier No 6.

Main danger Admiral Birnham was fourth in a qualified maiden last time so has to raise his game and he has taken his time in learning what it is all about, so switching back to Scottsville could be another hurdle as his
previous race at the course was a shocker.

All The Time contests Race 3, a Maiden Plate over 1200 m , and Yogas Govender's charge appeals as the best bets on the day as he has excellent form and has an inside gate, which traditionally has the faster going.

All The Time was expected to win after a good second at this venue but found one better (by a nose) in Tuk Tuk, a highly regarded runner from a top yard, at Greyville last time. He was trying
the turn for the first time while the winner had the necessary experience. All The Time is now meeting a field low on experience at Scottsville, where he has run well previously, so should prove hard to catch.

Global Vision has Highveld form and could be dangerous, but he has not raced since May, is drawn toward the outside and new trainer Mike Miller made the comment that he is working well but will probably need slightly further.

The R300,000 World Sports Betting Grand Heritage (Non-Black Type) remains the most unique race in the country for a number of reasons.

Firstly, it is the only local race to comprise more than 20 runners, secondly, it is run over the unusual distance of 1475 m and finally it is tailormade for lowerlevel horses to run for a big stake.

This year 26 horses have been declared to run in the Grand Heri-tage which will take place up the Vaal straight on Saturday 11 December.

As is so often the case, this event looks to be wide open, and it gives punters the opportunity to catch some huge payouts.

As was the case in the Gauteng Summer Cup, runners from the Sean Tarry yard dominate the field and he will saddle seven runners.

In fact, two of his runners Willow Express and Indlamu are among the four horses at the top of bookmakers' boards, and along with Approach Control and Bold Jazz, are quoted at 8-1.

Tarry has put Summer Cup winning jockey Calvin Habib on Willow Magic while Gavin Lerena is aboard Indlamu.

## Millard becomes doyen of the Hong Kong dirt

Tony Millard has taken up the mantle as Hong Kong racing's dirt specialist, building an exceptional strike-rate on the surface in the last season and a bit, and it bodes well for Sunday's Sha Tin meeting.

No one has had more winners on the all-weather track since the start of 2020-21, the South African tasting success on 10 occasions to share that mark with this season's championship-leading handler Frankie Lor Fu-chuen.

But while Lor is only slightly better on the dirt than the turf-10 from $67(14.9 \%)$ on the all-weather track and 80 of $657(12.2 \%)$ on the grass - the difference between the two marks for Millard is far more significant.

The 60-year-old has a strikerate of $20 \%$ on the dirt ( 10 of 50 ), compared to just $6.3 \%$ on the turf ( 27 of 427).

The surface has been a crucial part of Millard's haul over that period, providing $27 \%$ of his winners. In contrast, Lor's tally of 10 makes up just $11.1 \%$ of his victories.

It's a similar story for Francis Lui Kin-wai, who is next best with nine winners. He strikes at 10.5\% on the dirt (nine of 86) and 10.6\% on the turf ( 54 of 510 ), with $14.3 \%$ of his successes coming on the allweather track.
So, with those sort of numbers in play, punters need to pay close attention to the Millard runners when they step out on Sha Tin's inner circuit and there are three of
them who fit the bill for this weekend's meeting.

Silver Fig has been the stable's most prolific performer on the allweather track in 2021 with three wins from three starts over the 1200m course and he will compete in the Class Two Carbine Club Of Hong Kong 3oth Anniversary Cup.

Matthew Poon Ming-fai retains the ride and he is likely to get back from barrier No 1 before attempting to rattle over the top of his rivals, as has become his custom.

But it will not be easy as the contest is a hot one with Douglas Whyte's Will Power, the Benno Yung Tin-pang-trained Ka Ying Master and Chancheng Prince, from the Lui yard, all having won their most recent starts on the

Will Power races in a similar fashion to Silver Fig but will have to carry the top weight - even with Jerry Chau Chun-lok's 1.5 kg claim - Ka Ying Master is racing in good form and will be around the mark while Chancheng Prince has been a revelation in his two runs on the surface - winning both - but they were over 1650m.

The other stand-out dirt runner for Millard is Ultra Express, who was a last-start winner over 1650m.

The son of Power has not missed a place in any of his last eight runs, winning four of them, and he's drawn perfectly in barrier No 3 for the Class Three Peridot Handicap. Star jockey Joao Moreira
should be able to give him the gun run from there and even with the 60.5 kg impost, he looks the one to beat.

Elite Patch, Infinite Power and Super Win Dragon might provide the biggest challenges.

Millard's other competitor to grace the all-weather track is Fortune Patrol, who lines up in the Class Five Jasper Handicap (1650m), but the seven-year-old will need to improve markedly on his first two runs of the campaign if he is to figure in the finish.

Six of Sunday's 10 races are on the all-weather surface as officials look to protect the turf and ensure it is in pristine condition for next week's Longines Hong Kong International Races. - SCMP

# Flying Carpet rating raised to 116 

changes to merit ratings following the running of the Gauteng Summer Cup and other feature races at Turffontein on Tuesday.

WSB Gauteng Summer Cup (Handicap) (Grade 1)

FLYING CARPET has had his merit rating increased from 107 to 116 following his victory.
The handicappers took the view that consistent third finisher GOLDEN PHEASANT made for the most suitable line horse, leaving him unchanged on a rating of 112 .

It must be taken into account that FLYING CARPET was 4 kg under sufferance, especially as the specific conditions of the Summer Cup pegged the minimum weight to be carried at 54 kg and not the standard handicap 52 kg . This goes a long way towards the 4.5 kg ratings increase FLYING CARPET incurred for his victory.

Similarly, runner-up MAJESTIC MOZART was 2 kg under sufferance and accordingly his rating was raised from 110 to 114. Fourthplaced JOHNNY HERO, who was 4 kg out, but finished 0.75 lengths behind the line horse, has been raised from 106 to 110 and was the only other horse to receive ratings increase.

There were, however, rating drops for three horses. TIERRA DEL FUEGO was trimmed from 107 to 106, SECOND BASE drops to 115 from 117, and lastly SEEHAAM was dropped from 107 to 105 .

SAFE PASSAGE has seen his rating raised from 100 to 110 following his victory.

# Tough games for big guns 


#### Abstract

$\Rightarrow$ The leaders in several major leagues face tricky matches this weekend and these clashes add heaps of spice to a variety of TAB soccer pools like Soccer 10.

There are slippery stones that front-runners in several major leagues must tread carefully over this weekend, including a tricky trip to the Cape for unbeaten PSL log-leaders Mamelodi Sundowns
While their leadership of the DStv Premiership is not under threat, Sundowns travel to Stellenbosch tomorrow wary of the home team's high-speed attack.
