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# Big Burn to cast a spell

we are only a few weeks away from the start of the Highveld autumn season with the Grade 1 Gauteng Guineas and Gauteng Fillies Guineas scheduled to be run on Saturday 5 February.

Those two races see the start of the SA Triple Crown and Wilgerbosdrift SA Triple Tiara so warmups for those features now begin in earnest.

As a result we have some excellent racing at Turffontein tomorrow where we have some top horses in action

Heading up the card is the Listed Swallow Stakes for three-year-old fillies over 1160m and although only six runners have been carded to go to post, it looks quit a competitive race.

The two best performers in the line-up are Big Burn from the Paul Peter yard and Sean Tarrytrained Under Your Spell. Both were leading juveniles last season and have trained on well.

The edge in this race has to lie with Big Burn, who beat Under Your Spell by 1.60 lengths in the Grade 2 Joburg Spring Fillies And Mares Challenge over 1450 m on the Inside track at Turffontein in October.

Under Your Spell is 1 kg better off but that should not be enough to reverse the form.

Last time out Big Burn ran in the Grade 3 Magnolia Handicap over this course and distance but was touched off by another Tarrytrained filly, Sound Of Warning

going down by 0.25 lengths, but giving the winner 1.5 kg .

Tarry rates Sound Of Warning highly and took the filly to Cape Town to contest the Grade 2 Cartier Sceptre Stakes over 1200m at Kenilworth. She was priced up favourite for that event but had to be withdrawn at the start due to circumstances beyond her control.
Warren Kennedy rides Big Burn, while Calvin Habib will be aboard Under Your Spell.

Peter has good back-up in Freed From Desire and she is pretty speedy, too. She will be chasing a fourth successive victory and has
a top jockey in Gavin Lerena in the irons.

Every time War Of Athena comes to the racetrack it is a special occasion so most pundits will be delighted to see this four-yearold daughter of Act Of War line up in Race 4, a Pinnacle Stakes over 1400m.

Paul Matchett's charge is preparing to line up in the Cape Town Met at Kenilworth on Saturday 29 January and this will be her final warm-up run for the Grade 1 race over 2000m.

This distance is a little on the sharp side for her but she does have a record of three wins and
two places from five runs over 1400m at this track.
Ironically, one of the horses who inflicted one of those defeats will line up against her and that is MK's Pride.

It was in the Ready To Run Cup that Paul Peter's charge fought on strongly to gain a miniscule victory over the filly.

Both have come on a lot since then but interestingly, MK's Pride is now 1.5 kg better off so we could be in for a fascinating race.

Warren Kennedy still rides MK's Pride but Muzi Yeni will replace S'manga Khumalo aboard War Of Athena for this clash.

## Rainbow <br> Bridge retires

An injury has forced one of South Africa's great horse, Rainbow Bridge, into retirement.

In a statement released yesterday, trainer Eric Sands broke the sad news to the racing public.

He wrote: In the words of Mrs Norma Rattray: "All good things must come to an end.

Sands added: I was very pleased with Rainbow Bridge's effort in the L'Ormarins Queen's Plate on Saturday. A perfect run, in preparation for the upcoming Cape Town Met.

But it is not to be. He jarred his near fore knee in the race, and it has got progressively worse throughout the week. After consultation with (owners) Mr and Mrs Rattray, we have decided it is in the best interest of Rainbow, as he is affectionately known in the stable, to retire him. He has done us proud, and his well-being is first and foremost.

It was a tough decision for many, but not so in the case of the Rattrays. They would never risk their Horse Of The Year being seriously injured. It is an honour and a privilege to train for such owners.

After them, I spoke to Mary Slack, who bred Rainbow Bridge at Wilgerbosdrift Stud. Sad, yes, but the decision was unanimous. Rainbow deserves the best.

He will stay in my yard until he is ready to travel back to his "nirvana" at Wilgerbosdrift. In the yard we will embrace his well-deserved retirement.
I "found" him on the farm, as I did with my previous Horse Of Yhe Year Flobayou, and I must go searching again.

A big thank you to all his supporters.

The seven-year-old son of Ideal World raced 26 times for 11 wins and 13 places. He won five Grade 1 races - the Cape Town Met twice, the Gold Challenge twice and the Champions Cup.

Everyone is excited to see Lyle Hewitson back in the saddle - except, it seems, the barrier gods. The three-time champion jockey of South Africa has eight rides at Sha Tin on Sunday, his first meeting back after recovering from a fractured pelvis suffered in the horrific fall during last month's Group 1 Hong Kong Sprint.

Hewitson bore the brunt of the impact - his horse Amazing Star was the one who broke down, instigating the crash - so it is fantastic to see him make his return so quickly.

His physical health is one thing, but riders also need to be in the right head space to enter the field of battle and Hewitson has no doubt he's ready to go.
"It can affect some people mentally, you get on and you're a little bit nervous or a little bit more cautious but I've had a couple of falls and - whether small or big - I've never been one to came back and say "let me get my confidence back on the horse again'. It's all I've wanted to ever do - I just want to ride all the time," Hewitson said.
"So from a mental side of things, it's never been something that's affected me so I was more excited to ride again - my confidence never left.
"In this instance especially, I was knocked out and I don't remember much of it - I can't even replay what happened in my mind, so it didn't happen accord-
ing to my memory.
'I've watched it but it feels like I'm watching someone else. It's like I'm watching from an outside perspective-it's strange."

The 24 -year-old has ticked all the boxes with his medical team, been back at trackwork for a week and ridden in a few trials so now it's time to get back to work.
"My pelvis is great - there are no issues at all. I've been hiking the last few days and I'm getting through it really well and probably the last five days I've realised I'm able to run properly again - I just needed the muscles to activate again. So in terms of my wellbeing I'm 100 per cent and now with racing I'll be getting 100 per cent race fit," he said.
"It feels like I never left. In fact, when I first started riding trackwork again I was more comfortable in the saddle than I was walking or jogging. It was really easy and really comfortable.
"I could have easily ridden on Wednesday night but I never had a card of rides pre-booked so I thought the extra four days would benefit me to build me up a bit more - get some more fitness and plan some rides. Going into the meeting, I'm happy with how everything is feeling."

Having eight rides in his first meeting back exceeds Hewitson's expectations but given his second Hong Kong stint has only just started, he's delighted with the outcome.
"I had five rides pre-booked and I was happy with that and then when the entries came out I kept getting offers and I'm still building a foundation and building relationships so I was more than happy to take them - I was pretty pleased to be getting the offers," he said.

"It will be a test but I've done what I can going into the meeting and I feel good about that."

The only real negative came on Thursday morning when the fields were announced and Hewitson realised six of his eight mounts had been handed doubledigit draws - and another given barrier nine - which doesn't seem particularly fair in the circumstances.
"It's a difficult pill to swallow but you can't change it now so no point in harping on it from my perspective," he said. "I've just got to work hard to give them the best rides from those draws."

The South African rates the Douglas Whyte-trained Shining Red, who he partners in the Class Four Shek Kip Mei Handicap ( $1,400 \mathrm{~m}$ ) as his best chance.
"He ran a cracker on debut and he had excuses in his second start. He's had some rest since then and they've managed to get two trials into him - I think he's a decent sort," Hewitson said.
"I just think he's the type of horse that has upside because he's not exposed. There could be quite a bit more there. If things go smoothly from the draw, I'm sure he'll be there." - South China Morning Post

Jack Milner
The Listed Michael Roberts Stakes over 1750m heads up the Scottsville card on Sunday and it is another feature that could be fought out by raiding trainers.

Justin Snaith sends out Crown Towers, who won The Sledgeham mer (Listed) over this course and distance last year in his only visit to Scottsville. The nine-time winner from 25 starts is a strong front runner and is hard to catch when in a galloping mood.

Paul Peter sends Astrix, who has been running in far stronger company and placed in the Grade 2 OnamissionMile, the Grade 3 Victory Moon Stakes and the Grade 3 London News Stakes.

The pair will occupy the first two barrier position and will be ridden by Anton Marcus and Warren Kennedy respectively.
The race is usually a thriller and can boast some very useful individuals.

Tristful would be deserving and he is of the calibre of Crown Towers, Astrix and a few others but he has again been given a tough task jump ing from stall No 12 , which is not go ing to help his chances.

Capoeira is another who is capable on his day but another to consider, although not well weighted is Spring Fling. He has his work cu out but he likes the course and has S'manga Khumalo up, which could help his chances.
Peter's day should start off with a bang as he looks to have placed Maradiva well in Race 1, a Maiden Plate over 1000m. The Twice Over three-year-old moved from Cape Town to Peter late last year and obviouwsly enjoyed his new surrounding as he notched up two quick seconds, both over 10oom.

## Merit rating changes after Queen's Plate Festival

There were a number of alterations to the merit rating of runners who featured prominently at the two-day L'Ormarins Queen's Plate Festival at Kenilworth last weekend.
The main even was the Grade 1 L'Ormarins Queen's Plate over 1600m won for the second successive year by Jet Dark. He remains unchanged on a merit rating of 130 as he was deemed to make for the best line horse when assessing this race, which is the reason for his unchanged rating.

Fourth-placed Seeking The Stars was raised from 121 to 124, while fifth finisher Pomp And Power goes up from 110 to 117. In rating the race this way, Pomp And Power actually runs to a mark of 124, but the Handicappers were reluctant to take this entirely at face value and opted to give the gelding half the achieved adjustment, with 117 being halfway between his old rating of 110 and 124 .

There was one further increase, and this was for sixth placed Pacaya, who is up from 95 to 108 in order to
make him rated two points higher than the 106-rated eighth finisher Trip Of Fortune.

The only drop was for thirdplaced Rainbow Bridge, who has failed to confirm the 134 he achieved when winning the 2021 Cape Met in five subsequent performances and has accordingly been adjusted to his next highest performance of 130 .
This also ensures he is not rated higher than the Jet Dark, who beat Rainbow Bridge into second when winning the race last year.

Captain's Ransom remains unchanged on a mark of 126 following her success in the WFA Grade 1 Cartier Paddock Stakes for fillies and mares over 1800m.

It was the ever-consistent fourthplaced Princess Calla who was considered to make for the most suitable line horse, which leaves her unchanged on a mark of 118. In rating the race this way, Captain's Ransom only runs to a rating of 119, hence her unaltered rating.

Fifth-placed She's A Keeper also
runs to her rating of 116 , effectively making her a line horse as well.
Second-placed Chansonette is up from 110 to 118, while third-placed Marina goes up from 110 to 118.

The only other increase was for Eastern Cape visitor Santa Therese, who is up from 104 to 106, which ensures she is rated higher than any of the horses who finished behind her

The only drop was for Pretty Betty, who is down from 106 to 104.

Hoedspruit remains unchanged on a rating of 116 after his win in the Grade 2 Glorious Goodwood Premier Trophy over 1800 m .

The Handicappers were of the view fifth-placed Native Tongue made for the most appropriate line horse, leaving him unchanged on a rating of 105 . In assessing the race this way Hoedspruit only runs to a mark of 108 , which is the reason for his unaltered rating.

Runner-up Super Silvano was raised from 105 to 107, while the only other ratings increase was for third placed Firealley, who goes up from

## 107 to 109.

Two horses were given a rating's drop. Fourth-placed Sovereign Spirit is down from 118 to 116 and in all likelihood would have been given a bigger drop had he not returned suffering from a bilateral nosebleed, for which he has received a 120 -day suspension from competing in races.

The only other drop was for Nexus, who is down from 116 to 113.

Doublemint remains unchanged on a mark of 110 following his victory in the Grade 3 Okapi Chairman's Cup over 2500 m .
Fifth-placed Holy Warrior was deemed the best line horse, which leaves him unchanged on a rating of 93 . In assessing the race this way, Doublemint runs slightly below his rating, running to a mark of 110, which explains his unchanged rating.
The specific conditions of this event do not allow for any increase to the ratings of horses other than the winner although runner-up One Way Traffic and Sudden Star ran
above their reeopective ratings.
Gimme Dat's rating was raised from 98 to 109 after winning the Grade 2 Cartier Sceptre Stakes for fillies and mares over 1200 m at Ke nilworth in very unusual circumstances on Friday.
She originally finished second behind Mercury Rising but the latter was deemed to have enjoyed an unfair advantage as a result of her starting gate opening prematurely and was accordingly declared to be a non-runner.

Highly consistent second-placed Capitana was used as the line horse leaving her rating unchanged on 106. In assessing the race this way sixth-placed Dancetildaylight runs to her rating of 96 and effectively makes her a line horse as well.

The winner aside, the only other increase was for third-placed Major Attraction who is up from 100 to 103, but no fewer than five horses were given a rating's drop.-Phil's Dancer, Maryah, Keep The Lights On, Iris and Roll In The Hay.

# Watson on the comeback trail 

BATTLE: CHAMPION TRAINER OUT IN FULL FORCE IN ORDER TO RETAIN DUBAI TITLE

seven-time UAE Champion trainer Doug Watson is facing a tough battle to retain his crown. The American currently three wins behind Bhupat Seemar, will be eager to get among at the winners at Jebel Ali tomorrow, and give his title ambitions a boost and close the gap on Seemar.

Based at Red Stables in Dubai, Watson is taking a big team to the Dubai track's opening meeting of the year. In the feature in Race 5, an $1800 m$ Handicap, Watson runs US import American Dancer, Exciting Days and Al Murqab, the mount of Pat Dobbs.

The last-named, a winner at Jebel Ali on his seasonal reappearance in October, holds the strongest claims of the trio and has a solid chance of taking the prize.

The Canadian-bred gelding wasn't beaten far on his most recent start when a staying on second to Desert Wisdom in a minor event over 1400 m at Jebel Ali. The winner gave the form a major boost when giving the highly regarded Al Nefud a minor fright at Meydan last week.

Al Murqab is likely to find the step up to 1800 m in his favour and can take his career tally to two on his sixth visit to Jebel Ali.

It's hard to ignore the claims of Prevent, a winner at Jebel Ali earlier in the season in the hands of Ray Dawson for his main employer Ahmad bin Harmash, a yard that has enjoyed a revival this season.

He failed to follow up next time, getting caught in the dying strides by Capla Crusader, the pair clear of Law Of Peace who went on to

win a competitive handicap at Meydan eight days ago. Prevent, a consistent and reliable type, is ideally berthed in stall No 1 , and can be trusted to give a good account.
Top-weight Tenbury Wells caught the eye on his local debut for new trainer Salem bin Ghadayer in November. Ridden by Royston Ffrench, he lost out narrowly to the progressive Remorse having travelled nicely throughout the race. It was a highly encouraging performance on his first start on dirt from the wellbred gelding.

He has disappointed twice since, the latest when was pulled up behind Down On Da Bayou. He had a valid excuse and was found to be lame after the race. If he can
bounce back, he's worth giving another chance.

Monoski, bin Ghadayer's second runner, has the assistance of Royston Ffrench and has progressed with racing since returning from his summer break. Runner-up in his last two races, he ought to go well and demands respect.

George Villiers, returning after a lengthy break, looks Zabeel Stables main hope with Tadhg O'Shea up.

He chased home the course specialist Just A Penny on his only start at Jebel Ali. He's having his first run since being gelded.

Bin Ghadayer and Ffrench team up with Rawy in Race 2, a 1200m maiden. Owned by RRR Racing, he ran well on his race-
course debut at Meydan when second to Summer Is Tomorrow, keeping on nicely in the closing stages. In a modest looking event, he will take plenty of beating and rates the best bet on the card.
Sadaaty, trained on the track by Nicholas Bachalard, is an interesting runner on his first start in public. By Munnings, sire of the smart filly Shahama, he's bred to be useful and cost connections \$380,000 (R5.8m) at Keeneland's September Yearling Sale. If the market speaks in his favour, he merits consideration.
Racing ends with another maiden, over 1600 m , in which 14 go to post. Pat Dobbs has chosen Hero d'Oro, the well-bred five-year-old has looked one-paced in all his three runs his races since
joining Red Stables. The stiff tes at Jebel Ali is likely to suit and its significant Dobbs has elected to keep the ride on the son of Medaglia d'Oro.

Sam Hitchcott has picked up the ride Sharp Spun. He shaped with promise on his first start for Watson when splitting Rakeez and Sheringham in a similar event at Jebel Ali before Christmas

Having his first start for 293 days, he was noted putting in his best work in the closing stages and is entitled to step forward for the race.

A full field of 16 has been de clared for Race 4, a 1400 m handicap. Fawaareq, owned by Shadwell, is the only last-start winner in the field and holds sound claims of following up for Doug Watson. He showed a willing attitude to catch Dangerous Thought close home in a 1200m handicap at this course, snapping a lengthy losing run going back to July 2016.

Ahmad bin Harmash-trained Triple Venture, an unexposed colt, is worth considering despite flopping on his handicap debut at Meydan last time. He weakened badly in the closing stages having looked a threat off the hometurn over 1900m.

He showed promise on his debut behind Zero To Hundred, leaving the impression he was a future winner.

He travels strongly in his races, suggesting dropping back the son of Elusive Quality in distance is a wise decision.

# Lim's Kosciuszko to keep unbeaten record intact

A high-quality Kranji Stakes A race over 1200m on turf is slated as the feature event at Kranji tomorrow, where there is a 12 -race card for the third meeting of the 2022 season.

There's also plenty of talent on the undercard. Of those, un beaten four-year-old LIM'S KO SCIUSZKO for trainer Daniel Meagher makes his eagerly await ed return in the Class 3 Handicap
over 1200 m on turf
LIM'S KOSCIUSZKO has done nothing wrong so far, boasting an unblemished record of four wins from as many starts. He was most impressive last time when showing blistering early toe and leading all the way to score by 3.50 lengths over this track and distance. His winning time of the race, which was a Class 4 event, was only 0.02 seconds slower than the Class 1 race won by top class sprinter KHARISMA on the same day.

Resuming off a 62 -day break, LIM'S KOSCIUSZKO is well prepared with two barrier trials for his return, and he looks all set to continue his winning ways.
Elsewhere, promising five-year-old KING'S COMMAND is one on whom to keep a keen eye as he returns in the Kranji Stakes C race over 1600 m on turf.
KING'S COMMAND had been on a winning streak of two before finishing a credible eighth in the Group 1 Singapore Gold Cup last start. Drawn wide on that
occasion, the Tavistock gelding settled towards the rear of the field before reeling off the third fastest final $400 \mathrm{~m}(24.17 \mathrm{sec})$ to flash home late, missing by 4.75 lengths on the wire.
KING'S COMMAND outper formed his rating that day and looks in for a big season. This week's race, however, is a smal and tactically tricky affair.

Stablemate RED OCEAN may be left alone enough on the lead to get the job done while the likes of SPECIAL OPS demand plenty of

# Seemar saddles five in feature 

STRONG CARD: 2022 DUBAI WORLD CUP CARNIVAL KICKS OFF AT MEYDAN

# $\rightarrow$ Majestic Mambo to improve back on the turf in Race 3.

The opening meeting of the 2022 Dubai World Cup Carnival at Meydan today is a cracking sev-en-race card, headlined by a strong renewal of the Al Maktoum Challenge Round I.

The Group 2 event over 1600m on dirt has attracted a stellar lineup, led by Godolphin Mile winner Secret Ambition, one of five runners representing bang-in-form Bhupat Seemar.

Based at Zabeel Stables in Dubai, Seemar is enjoying a remarkable campaign since getting his licence in November and is operating at a $19 \%$ strike-rate at Meydan.

Secret Ambition, the choice of Tadhg O'Shea, is the oldest horse in the 14-runner contest and makes his seasonal reappearance. The son of Exceed And Excel, a confirmed front-runner is nicely drawn in stall No 5 and if primed and ready following a near 10-month break, has strong claims of registering an eighth victory at Meydan and advertising his claims for the Saudi Cup next month.
The former Clive Cox-trained Salute The Soldier has thrived in the Middle East since switched to dirt and joining Fawzi Nass, winning the final two legs of the Al Maktoum Challenge last season.

He must be respected despite being off the track since March when finishing a creditable fifth behind Mystic Guide in the Dubai World Cup. He goes well fresh and hails from a yard enjoying a fantastic season, particularly at Meydan having sent out four winners from just 13 runners.

Doug Watson, successful with Kimbear in the 2020, fields a strong team led by last season's runner-up Thegreatcollection, Golden Goal and Midnight Sands, winner of six of his eight races at Meydan.

Pat Dobbs, Watson's stable jockey, remains loyal to Midnight Sands. The six-year-old has to bounce back after a lacklustre effort in the Dubai Creek Mile, weakening in the closing stages to finish eight lengths behind Tuz on his first start of the campaign.

Thegreatcollection, the mount of Pat Cosgrave, made an encouraging comeback in the same race, staying on nicely to chase home the Seemar-trained winner. He's entitled to strip fitter for the race and is one to consider.

Golden Goal, who holds the 1400m dirt track record at Meydan, was less than two lengths behind Thegreatcollection in the Dubai Creek Mile, a pleasing effort on his seasonal debut. From an inside gate, he should enjoy a ground saving trip and can't be overlooked in an open race.
The ex-Godolphin owned Eastern World, an AE220,000 (R930,ooo) purchase at the Racing In Dubai Sale in September, made a very good start for new connections when second to Tuz last month on his first start on the dirt surface at Meydan. By Dubawi, the most successful sire on Meydan's main track, he shaped as he would step forward for the race, understandable having been off the track since June.

Trained by Ahmad bin Harmash, he could provide his talented rider Ray Dawson with the biggest win of his career.

William Buick has been booked to ride the exciting and unbeaten Kafoo, trained by Seemar. Formerly trained by Bob Baffert, he created a big impression on his racecourse debut, defeating Al Maroom and eight others in scintillating fashion in a 1600 m maid-
en at this course in November. Raised in class next time, the son of Curlin had to battle hard and eventually prevailed by a short head from Prince Eiji, showing a likeable attitude for an inexperienced colt. He will have learnt plenty from that and is one for the shortlist.

The Cape Verdi, the Group 2 for fillies and mare, is the highlight of the rest of the card and this year's renewal, run over a 1600 m on grass, has attracted Down On Da Bayou, Mnasek and Soft Whisper, all former Classic winners at Meydan.

Saeed bin Suroor, the most successful trainer in the history of the race with five wins, trains Soft Whisper, winner of the UAE 1000 Guineas last season.

Winner of half of her six races on turf, she boasts the highest handicap rating, 106, and looks the one to beat in what looks a below average renewal. She has the assistance of Franke Dettori and should prove too classy for her nine rivals.

Charlie Appleby, seeking a fourth consecutive victory, is represented by Wedding Dance, the mount of William Buick. The daughter of Shamardal, owned and bred by Godolphin, is a lightly raced filly who arrives in Dubai on the back of a career high performance on the all-weather at Wolverhampton two months ago. She recovered from a tardy start before running out a comfortable winner of a minor event. She can emerge the chief threat to Soft Whisper.

Majestic Mambo, Mike de Kock's only runner on the card, is fitted with first-time blinkers when he faces 15 rivals in Race 3 .

The Mambo In Seattle gelding struggled on his seasonal reappearance, trailing in a distance behind Desert Peace when the race was switched to dirt after heavy rain caused the cancellation of all turf races on New Year's
