# Smorgasbord a tasty bet

Gelding seems to have done the trick for Smorgasbord who bounced back to his best in his first race after having the surgical procedure done.

Very highly rated by trainer Paul Peter, this son of Twice Over looked to be heading straight to the top after winning on debut by 3.25 lengths. His future seemed even brighter when three winners came out of that form line but unfortunately he started to have behavioural issues.

When it became clear there was no other option Smorgasbord was gelded.

The three-year-old returned to racing on 30 December over 1200 m at the Vaal, and despite a slow start, came from last and won more comfortably than the winning margin of 0.90 lengths suggests.

Tomorrow he will again race

over 1200m in Race 5, a MR 96 Handicap, this time on the Inside track at Turffontein, which means he will be running around the turn.
It should not be much of an issue as he has run at the course when finishing a $2.10-$ length third over 1450m in a much stronger field. That race was won by Mike de Kock-trained Sparkling Water, who has since gone on to win the Grade 3 Victory Moon Stakes and
will be contesting a Grade 2 feature at Kenilworth in Cape Town on 29 January. Gavin Lerena rode him to victory last time and will be on board for this race

His main threat is likely to come from another three-year old, Quantum King, from the Johan Janse van Vuuren yard

He has run three times over the course and distance for two wins and a second so he extremely comfortable on this track. He will
be in receipt of 4 kg from Smorgasbord but Peter will have some idea of how good the match-up between the two will be as he has a line through another of his runners.

Freed From Desire beat Quantum King by a head, giving him 0.5 kg and he will have some idea where Smorgasbord will fit into this picture.

Keagan de Melo has been engaged to ride Quantum King.

Many punters follow Anton Marcus as he does ride a lot of winners. Knowing that, bookmakers tend to price up everything he rides shorter than they probably should be.

However, it is a little unfair to expect him to win on everything he rides.

Having said that, he does have some decent rides on Hollywoodbets Scottsville today and hopefully he can ride a winner or two.
Ancient Epic's last races entitles her to being the form choice for Marcus in Race 6, a MR 73 Handicap for fillies and mares over 1000 m .
While there are useful sorts
in the race, she looks the best of
them as she has yet to run out of the money and more importantly, backed up her maiden win with a second place in better company last time out.

That formline has produced two recent winners in Princess Donnelly and Purple Merchant, who finished behind her.

The two strongest contenders in Race 8, a Maiden Plate over 16oom, are Marcus-ridden

Napoleon and Cyber Time with Muzi Yeni up. Napoleon was a bit costly to follow when a beaten favourite last time - he may not have enjoyed the slow track and slow-run race.

But despite a wide draw, Marcus has stuck with him.
However, Cyber Time, although improving, has an even wider draw so that should level the playing fields.

## Katak strikes in

## Singapore

Trainer Ricardo Le Grange was a relieved and thankful man after well-credentialled South African import Katak opened his Singapore account at his fifth start on Saturday.
The 2020 Cape Winter Series winner has not quite lived up to his South African billing in four Kranji starts, including the last three in the Group 1 events other than a close second to Hard Too Think in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup over 1800m in October

But visible signs of improve ment have been seen on the training tracks since the December break, franked by a winning barrier trial last week.

Lined up in Saturday's $\$ 85,000$ (R955,ooo) Class 2 race over 1400m, he came across from his wide alley to sit alongside the well-backed and expected raceleader Nepean (Manoel Nunes).

Danny Beasley allowed the five-year-old son of Potala Palace to draw on level terms with Ne pean turning for home.

The tussle was brief. Katak gave Nepean's resistance short shrift to put a space of two lengths on the rest.

Le Grange said he had already been taken by what he saw from Katak in the parade ring - a more collected demeanour that could only be more conducive for a first visit at the Kranji winner's circle.
"He has settled so much better. He wasn't sweating, he was conserving his energy so well, when he used to use it up a lot before the race last time," said the South African handler whose second runner Pennywise (A'Isisuhairi Kasim) ran a creditable fifth.
"Mind you, he's still not fully wound up, and that first race back will bring him on.
"I will now run him in a Class 1 race over the mile on 26 February, and probably look for another race before the Kranji Mile which is his main target." - Singapore Turf Club
